WINNER ANNOUNCED FOR JAPAN FINANCIAL INNOVATION AWARD 2021
 ~Innovative in Financial Service Awarded and Grand Prize to be announced on Feb. 26~

TOKYO, Jan. 28, 2021 – FINOLAB Inc. and FINOVATORS – have announced the winners of “Japan Financial Innovation Award 2021 (JFIA2021)” of the respective category.



JFIA was inaugurated last year to promote innovative initiatives in financial area by adopting information technology and share best practices in the industry and expected to further expand open innovation beyond the corporate group and business sector. JFIA2021 consists of 3 categories, including Startup, Financial Institution, and Collaboration. FINOLAB, the FinTech Center of Tokyo, administrated the evaluation process by extracting about 600 innovative initiatives from press releases during the year 2020. And final candidates and winners were selected by the group of professionals, FINOVATORS, based on the judgement on innovation, growth, and transformation.
