## FINAL RESULT ANNOUNCED FOR JAPAN FINANCIAL INNOVATION AWARD 2023 $\sim$ GRAND PRIX AWARDED TO Credit Saison Co.,Ltd. $\sim$

TOKYO, Mar. 10, 2023 - FINOLAB Inc. and FINOVATORS - have announced Grand Prix and Category Excellence for the respective category for "Japan Financial Innovation Award 2023 (JFIA2023) " on Mar. 10 at "Future Frontier Fes by FINOLAB (4F)."

JFIA was inaugurated in the Year 2020 to promote innovative initiatives in financial area by adopting information technology and to share best practices in the



industry, and expects to further expand open innovation beyond corporate groups and business sectors. JFIA2023 consists for 3 categories, including Startup, Financial Institution, and Collaboration.
